- Cooperation with local e-commerce
- Second Harvest from local farmer for food bank
- 378 kg vegetables rescued and distributed

Charity of Employee

- Community service from PT. Bio Farma (state-owned company)
- Food drive: 118 kg food
- Beneficiaries: 75 families
- Education: stunting prevention





Ramadhan program

- 500 packages sardines & vegetables
- Donor & partner: Kraft Heinz, Sayur Box & Food Cycle Indonesia

Food Rescue

- Food: Bread, cake, pastry, warm meal (Rice, fired chicken, beef)
